GENERAL RULES OF ENTRY

On Thursday, entry to the rally field will be from 12 noon (not before) to 9pm. Entry on Friday between 7am and 9pm, Saturday and Sunday will be between 7 a.m. and 9 a.m., before public are admitted on site. No vehicles will be admitted without the necessary passes which **MUST SHOW THE REGISTRATION DETAILS OF THAT VEHICLE**. Health and Safety demand that vehicle movement on site is marshaled at all times. Vehicles will not be permitted to leave the site until 4.30 p.m. on Saturday or Sunday. In the evenings, the gates will be closed by Security at 9 p.m. Entrants arriving after this time may park in the car park near to the main gate which is adjacent to the Security Marquee. To avoid accidents, vehicle owners are requested not to drive on the show ground after dark. The ropes and metal stakes can cause serious injury if pulled out of the ground by a moving vehicle in the darkness. A speed limit of 5 mph must be observed on the Pageant site. All vehicles must be covered by Rally insurance and driven only by persons authorised to drive, with the appropriate licenses.

ALL PERSONS WHO DRIVE A MOTOR VEHICLE ON THIS SITE MUST HOLD A VALID FULL DRIVING LICENCE AND BE INSURED AGAINST THIRD PARTY LIABILITY.

STALL SPACES

All stall spaces will be numbered and you will receive your vehicle pass showing this (or these) numbers in advance of the event providing that you enter in good time.

Please Note - Stall spaces are 6.1m (20ft) frontage x 6.1m (20ft) deep. Therefore, a double space would be 12.2m (40ft) frontage x 6.1m (20ft) deep.

IF YOU REQUIRE THE SAME STALL SPACE AS LAST YEAR, YOU MUST RETURN THIS FORM BY THE 31ST MARCH 2012. BOOKINGS RECEIVED AFTER THIS DATE WILL BE ALLOCATED THE NEXT AVAILABLE SPACE. UNFORTUNATELY THERE CAN BE NO EXCEPTIONS SO POST YOUR BOOKING AT YOUR EARLIEST OPPORTUNITY TO AVOID DISAPPOINTMENT.

Please make allowance for the size of your vehicle and stall. If you want to be next to friends, please apply as a group. Only ONE motor vehicle per plot is allowed. Extra vehicles need to be paid for at £10 (inclusive of driver) for a 3-day pass and £10 per extra person in that vehicle for a 3-day pass. Each stall rent includes entry to the event for two adults and two children (Provided they arrive in the paid for vehicle). Extra adult passes are available at £10 for a 3-day pass. All surplus vehicles MUST be parked in the car park provided for stallholders.

CHARGES

A 6.1m (20ft) x 6.1m (20ft) plot is charged at £87 for the duration of the show (No single day bookings will be accepted). **This will admit ONE MOTOR VEHICLE per stall space, TWO ADULTS and TWO CHILDREN in this vehicle.** Extra adult passes are available at £10 for a 3-day pass. Extra vehicles will be charged at the rate of £10 (inclusive of driver) for a 3-day pass and extra persons in that vehicle at the rate of £10 per person for a 3-day pass.

ITEMS TO BE SOLD

Autojumble Stalls must be items of a transport related nature. All other stalls must contain items of a collectable or general interest nature. No catering outlets, alcohol and tobacco stalls, tombola and gaming related stalls in any shape or form, no counterfeit goods, these are all specifically excluded.

VEHICLES FOR SALE

Autojumbler may display vehicles for sale provided the vehicle is within the bounds of their pre-booked pitch.

GROUND CONDITIONS

The movement of all vehicles on the Pageant site is subject to ground conditions. The London Borough of Enfield is tolerant of our use of the site but we would ask all drivers to restrict their movements when the ground is wet. Remember that the EDVVT are liable to The London Borough of Enfield for the reinstatement of all damage to the grounds.

VEHICLE WEIGHT/ SIZE RESTRICTION

Due to adverse ground conditions in past years, there is now a limit of 5.5 ton (5,588 kg) gross laden weight on all vehicles wishing access to the Autojumble area. Maximum size vehicles allowed: e.g. Transits, Sprinters, LDV, Luton etc. NO vehicles over 5.5 ton (5,588 kg) gross laden weight. NO HGV, Box Wagons or Flat Backs will be allowed on the site.

FACILITIES

Stallholders may camp or bring caravans on to the Autojumble site providing these are contained within their stall space. The site has a permanent toilet block with free showers. Refurbishment of these facilities is underway and availability is subject to work being completed on time. There will be portable toilets available on many parts of the site. On-site catering facilities will be available. All public parking is free of charge on the opposite side of the park.

SAFETY

Please do not let your stall encroach on to the roadway - it may well be you who needs an emergency vehicle.

Please read the Rules and disclaimer carefully and note that by signing an Entry Form you agree to abide by The Rules and the Instructions of the EDVVT stewards, and accept the other conditions
